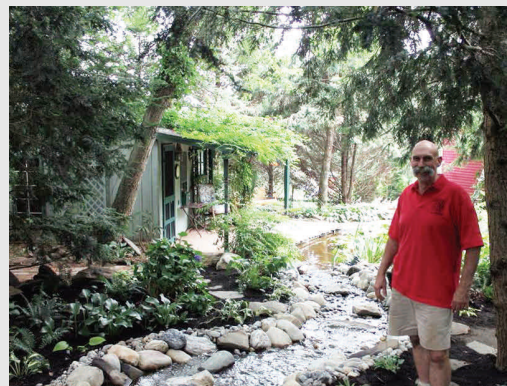

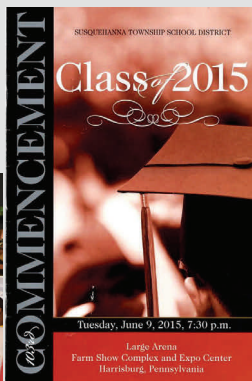

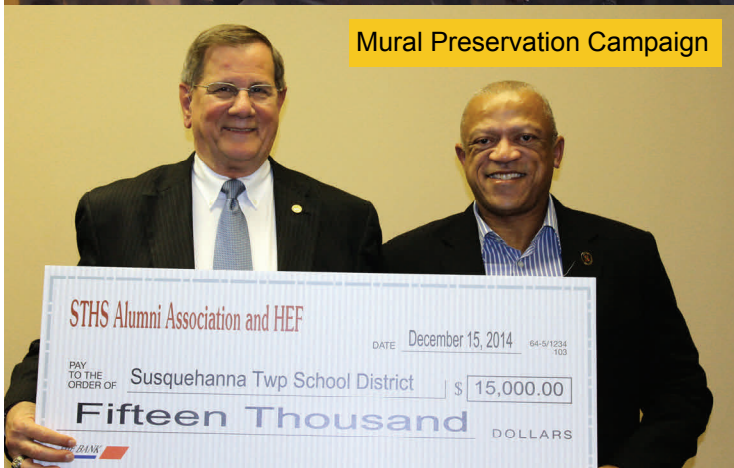

A second Dauphin County Local Share Municipal Grant application will be submitted during September. The additional funding request, and approval, will augment the earlier \$30,000 grant. We anticipate a 2017 dedication. The grant comes from community designated revenue generated by Hollywood Casino at Penn National. As needed, additional funds will be raised for sidewalks, shrubbery, benches, etc...

The memorial will contain names of STHS alumni or veterans who lived in the township and served in the military during the Vietnam War from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975.

We currently have 240 names of township Vietnam War Veterans. Keep them coming!
