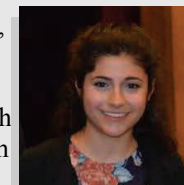
Bony Dawood '80 and *Dawood Engineering* raised

total figure to \$13.4 thousand.

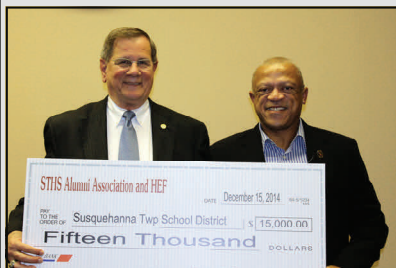
Vicki's Angels Foundation accepted a check for \$9,650 and *American Cancer*

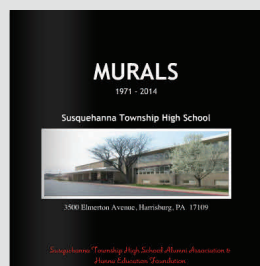

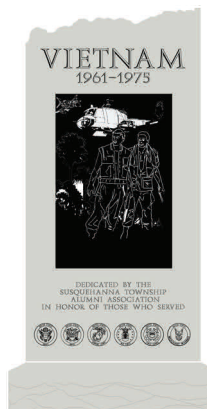

On November 20, **Eric Waters '86**, our Grant Writing Chair, along with **Shirley Kannegieser '50** and **Dwayne DeFoor '78**, presented the association's Grant funding request to the Dauphin Country Gaming Commission. The \$60,000 grant request will cover the construction of the memorial. Additional funds will be raised for sidewalks, shrubbery, flagpoles, benches, etc...

The memorial will contain names of STHS alumni or veterans who lived in the township and served in the military during the Vietnam War from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975.

David McCollum '73 celebrated his 500th win as the head coach of the Bermudian Springs High School wrestling team on December 20. Dave, who retired as a elementary teacher in 2012, has been the driving force behind the Bermudian Springs wrestling program since 1977.

Dave, who began wrestling in the seventh grade, compiled a 55-10 high school varsity record over three years. During his junior season, he was Capital Area Conference sectional champ and fourth in District 3 Regionals. Wrestling at 105 pounds in his senior season, Dave was named team co-captain, compiled a 19-0 record, and was selected to the Patriot-News Big 12 team.

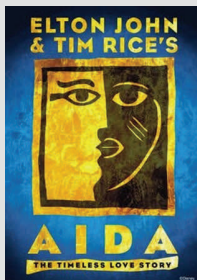
After graduation, Dave attended Bloomsburg where he wrestled on the JV team for his first two years before moving up to Varsity. As a junior, Dave finished fourth in the Eastern Wrestling League at 118 pounds and was voted "Most Improved Wrestler". In his senior season, he was voted team co-captain and compiled a record of 8-6-1.
