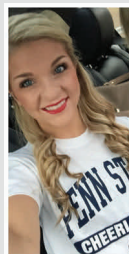

A Dauphin County Commissioner's \$30,000 grant will enable us to remain on track for a 2017 dedication. The grant comes from community designated revenue generated by Hollywood Casino at Penn National. Additional funds will be raised for sidewalks, shrubbery, flagpoles, benches, etc...

The memorial will contain names of STHS alumni or veterans who lived in the township and served in the military during the Vietnam War from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975.

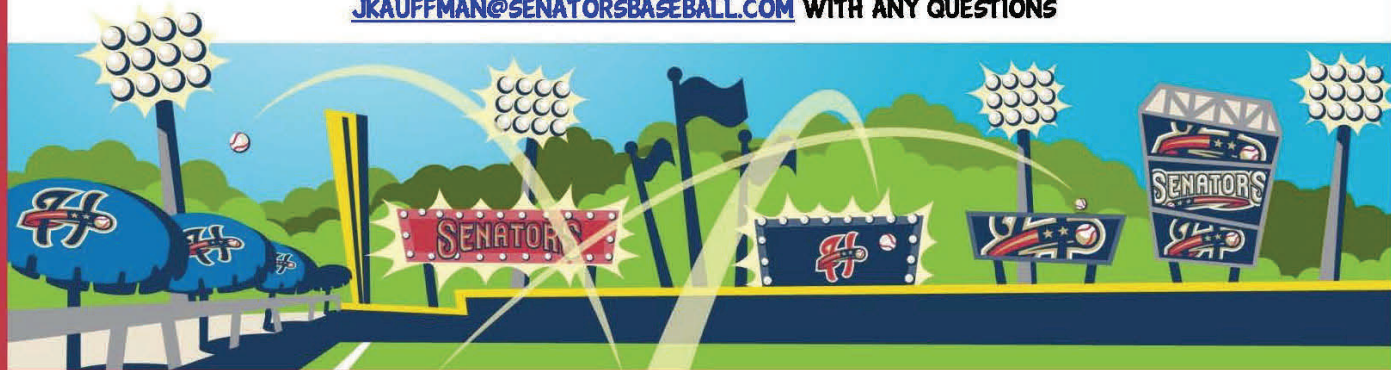
